Eberhard Ross (1959) is a recognized German artist, who has been painting and drawing for more than 30 years. He studied Fine Art at Hochschule Essen and at Kunstakademie Düsseldorf in Germany. His work is inspired by the philosophy of Zen Buddhism which is revealed in his art, both in the subject matter as in its execution. In his more abstract "Speicher" works, Ross painstakingly covers canvases, aluminium and sheets of drawing paper with calligraphic networks of lines and pattern that develop organically in a repetitive process. As he tries to interpret the natural lines and curves found in nature, he is also exploring how the tones and hues of colour are affected by the mark-making. Eberhard has been awarded more than once and his work can be found in several important museums and collections worldwide. 

The working processes for Ross' pieces don't allow for pauses: for the black and white writings for example a single, uninterrupted line is inscribed into the layers of paint. Ross here references a famous series by American painter Mark Tobey, who under the influence of Zen Buddhism tested out similar shapes. The Fermata series takes its name from the signs that indicate a sound or pause is to be held when playing a piece of music. And in similar vein, the Speicher are to capture and hold the fulfilled duration of their own becoming for inspection by the viewer. Music can aid us in making this duration tangible. "Music is carrying, structured time that can further be experienced through the senses."
